By signing below I hereby agree that:

- 1: I will lead by example and demonstrate good sportsmanship with fellow skaters, coaches, officials, parents, and other attendees at every game and practice.
- 2: I will treat my fellow committee members and coaches, visitors, officials and fans with respect regardless of age, race, gender, religion or ability.
- 3: I will notify my fellow coaches prior to training or a bout starting if I have any health issues or injuries
- 4: If I need help to deliver on my commitments to the juniors program I will ask for it.
- 5: I commit to an environment that is safe and free of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco.
- 6: I will learn the rules of roller derby according to the current WFTDA standard. (www.WFTDA.com)
- 7: I will not engage in any behaviour which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of coaches, parents, officials, my fellow team mates or any other attendees.
- 8: I will not engage in the use of profanity, verbal or physical threats, abuse, or any behavior that offends, humiliates or intimidates a person.
- 9: As a coach I commit to following the agreed guidelines when I need to leave the track during training
 - I will notify one of my peers,
 - I will spend a maximum 10 minutes off the track if I need a break, otherwise I will gear down after speaking with another coach or first aid officer.
 - If requested by 2 of my peers I will leave the track and or venue if required for my and or the juniors well being
- 10: If I feel at any time concerned about the health or well-being myself or anyone else at a junior derby event I will raise this to the Junior Committee so it can be reviewed and action taken as required.
- 11: If I suspect abuse of my peers or juniors I will follow the Skate Victoria policies and Victorian government legislation to ensure appropriate investigation and action.

If I fail to abide by the above code of conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action as deemed fit by the Junior Derby Committee that could include but is not limited to the following:

- (A) Verbal or written warning
- (B) Be requested to leave the track or premises
- (C) Committee or Coaching suspension
